

Iberdrola España Scholarships

**Call for Master's Degree Studies in Spain
Academic year 2026 to 2027**

February 2026

1. Presentation

Iberdrola, S.A.U. (hereinafter, “**Iberdrola España**”), with tax identification number (NIF) A-95758355 and registered office at Plaza Euskadi, number five, Bilbao (Bizkaia), seeks to strengthen its contribution to improving the quality of life of citizens in the regions and countries where it operates. To this end, it aims to provide effective responses to the fundamental needs of society, leveraging its business capabilities and strengths.

Iberdrola España also recognises that without the support of a qualified, diverse and motivated team, it would not be possible to achieve its strategic goals and that recruiting, selecting and retaining the best talent in accordance with current legislation and best professional practices is critical to the success of the Iberdrola Group's businesses. Thus the Sustainable Human Capital Management and Harassment Prevention Policy, among others, promotes access for young people to their first job through scholarship programmes and other agreements and presents candidates with a competitive value proposition that favours the selection and recruitment of the best professionals.

To this end Iberdrola España is launching its Call for Applications for Master's Degree Scholarships in Spain, to contribute to excellence in the training of young people, equipping them with a high level of qualification that will facilitate their access to their first job.

2. Call

Iberdrola España is offering scholarships for the 2026 to 2027 academic year to pursue postgraduate studies at different universities in the following areas of knowledge:

- Engineering
- Computer Science
- Mathematics, Big Data
- Cybersecurity
- Information and Communication Technologies
- Business Administration
- Digital Marketing

The call for applications opens on the date of its publication and closes **at 12:00 pm (Spanish time) on Wednesday, 1st of April**

The scholarships are intended for studies included in the campuses of excellence, at the regional or international level, with special consideration given to those from the following universities:

- Pontifical University of Comillas
- Carlos III University of Madrid

- Polytechnic University of Madrid
- University of the Basque Country
- Polytechnic University of Valencia
- University of Salamanca
- University of Edinburgh
- University of Strathclyde
- Imperial College London
- University of Rochester
- University of Connecticut

3. Applicant requirements

- Iberdrola España scholarships are open to students of any nationality residing in Spain.
- Applicants must hold a recognised university degree or bachelor's degree at the time of application. If the applicant is in their final year of study in the 2026 to 2027 academic year, the award of the scholarship will be conditional upon obtaining the university degree in the June to July 2027 session.
- The program will not accept applications certifying diploma or technical engineering studies.
- Language skills: all applicants must demonstrate excellent knowledge of English by submitting a certificate from a recognised institution.

The following English certificates will be accepted:

- University of Cambridge: First Certificate or higher
- IELTS (minimum score: 5.0 points).
- TOEFL (minimum score: 61 for Internet-based, 173 for computer-based or 500 for paper-based).
- Certificate of Proficiency in the Upper Cycle (old plan) or Certificate of Advanced Level B2 (new plan), taken and passed at official language schools.
 - Diplomas or certificates issued by university language schools certifying completion and passing of level B2 (or higher) of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

For universities in the United States, the minimum level required will be C1.

- The scholarship holder must not receive any financial compensation or remuneration during the period of the scholarship nor be the beneficiary of any scholarship, financial aid or any other similar allowance from public or private institutions and foundations.

- Not to provide services, either on their own account or for others, or maintain any employment relationship (under any type of contract), internship, training or any other nature, with other public or private entities during the period of the scholarship. Likewise, the scholarship holder shall notify Iberdrola España of their participation in selection processes for incorporation into other public or private entities, for the purpose of assessing their compatibility with the scholarship.
- Iberdrola España will exclude from consideration candidates who have been recipients of Iberdrola España Foundation Scholarships and Iberdrola España Master's Scholarships in previous calls.

4. Documentation

To apply for the scholarship, applicants must submit the completed electronic application form before **12:00 pm (Spanish time) on Wednesday, 1st of April**, attaching the documents specified below, which must be named with the document number followed by the applicant's surname.

- Document 1. Photocopy of **national identity card or passport**.
- Document 2. Applicant's **curriculum vitae**.
- Document 3. **Higher education degree or proof** of application for the same, as well as the degrees for all studies listed on the form. Only candidates who are yet to complete their studies may attach their academic certificate instead of their degree in this section.
- Document 4. **Complete academic certificate** for undergraduate or bachelor's degree studies, showing the **average mark** for the studies completed, all subjects and grades, year by year, as well as the credits passed. If you have completed a first and second cycle of different degrees, you must submit both certificates. Students enrolled in the final year of their degree must provide academic certification of the courses and subjects completed.
- Document 5. **Two original letters of reference** from university professors. In cases where the applicant has been working for several years, one of the letters of reference may be from their direct supervisor.
- Document 6. **Certificate attesting to the level of all languages** specified in the form.
- Document 7. Certificate accrediting the **awards and scholarships** specified in the form. Only awards and scholarships obtained since the start of university studies will be considered.

If you pass the pre-selection process, Iberdrola España may require you to submit the original or certified copies of the documents and any other documents it deems necessary.

The maximum size allowed per document is 5 megabytes.

5. Selection process

Pre-selection

The selection process will include an initial preselection of candidates, taking into account the candidate's profile, academic qualifications, level of English, CV, interest in the study project and letters of reference.

Selection process

If the candidate passes the pre-selection stage, the Iberdrola España selection committee may, at its discretion, arrange for the candidate to complete the various stages of the selection process in person. The aim will be to assess their personal skills, comprehensive training and motivation.

If attendance at the process involves travel and/or accommodation costs exceeding €15, candidates may request compensation of up to €100 for travel within the Iberian Peninsula, subject to justification of expenses. This amount may be increased to €150 in the case of travel from outside the Iberian Peninsula.

Iberdrola España may declare this call for applications void for all or some of the scholarships offered if the selection committee or the person responsible for the Scholarship Programme so proposes to Iberdrola España.

6. Appointment of candidates

The selection committee will propose the list of selected candidates. Iberdrola España will make the final decision on the candidates who are ultimately admitted. They will be notified on **12 June 2026** by personalised email.

The list of candidates approved by Iberdrola España is final and cannot be appealed. Iberdrola España will not provide information on rejected applications.

The final appointment of candidates is subject to compliance with the following conditions:

- Send a signed **Letter of Acceptance** dated no more than five working days from the date of notification to the beneficiaries to the following email address: programa.becas.iberdrola@iberdrola.es . We will provide the text of the Letter of Acceptance to beneficiaries by email on the same date that we notify the final candidates.

- Submit to Iberdrola España before the estimated date of **24 July 2026** certification of enrolment or definitive admission to study the corresponding course at the chosen university. This date will be flexible depending on the deadlines for notification of admission by each university. In the event of non-admission the candidate will lose the right to the scholarship.
- Final-year students must submit **full academic** certification of completed undergraduate or bachelor's degree studies showing the average grade for the studies completed and all subjects and grades year by year as well as the credits passed. Failure to complete the studies will result in the cancellation of the scholarship.

7. Financial endowment and taxes

The scholarship will cover the following items:

- Tuition fees at a university or higher education institution in Spain, the United Kingdom or the United States.
- Master's degree in Spain: €10,800 per year to cover transport and accommodation costs. The foundation will pay this amount in nine monthly instalments of €1,200.
- Master's degree in the United Kingdom: €18,960 per year to cover transport and accommodation costs. The foundation will pay this amount in 12 monthly instalments of €1,580.
- Master's degree in the United States: €24,000 per year to cover transport and accommodation costs. The foundation will pay this amount in 12 monthly instalments of €2,000.
- Health and accident insurance.
- Travel grant of €1,500 for a transatlantic return flight to carry out the studies covered by the scholarship.

The duration of the grant will be a maximum of one calendar year from the start of the study programme.

The scholarship recipient undertakes to comply with all tax obligations applicable to them as a beneficiary of the scholarship.

8. Scholarship management

The scholarship recipient undertakes to comply with the following obligations:

- At the request of Iberdrola España, candidates must provide original or certified copies of the information submitted during the selection process in the form of photocopies or electronic files. Iberdrola España may also request certification of any information provided in their CV.
- Complete the planned studies, in accordance with the application submitted. Candidates who obtain a scholarship will be required to begin the study programme in the September to October term of the 2026 to

2027 academic year and complete it within the estimated time frame set out in the study plan (generally June/July 2027).

- If the scholarship is awarded for programmes that include an internship module, the scholarship holder undertakes to carry out said internship at the Iberdrola Group company designated by Iberdrola España, where applicable. If the studies for which the scholarship is awarded include compulsory paid internships to be carried out at an entity other than and outside the Iberdrola Group, the scholarship holder is obliged to notify Iberdrola España as far in advance as possible. The amount received for the aforementioned internships may be deducted from the scholarship award.
- During the period of the master's degree and the associated unpaid work experience, lasting between three and six months, the scholarship recipient undertakes to accept any job offer made by the company to join the Iberdrola Group company designated by Iberdrola España.

All of this takes into account that the call for these scholarships is linked to the Sustainable Human Capital Management and Harassment Prevention Policy, which promotes, among other basic principles, facilitating young people's access to their first job through scholarship programmes and other agreements, offering scholarship recipients a competitive value proposition that favours the selection and hiring of the best professionals.

- Likewise the scholarship recipient undertakes to send Iberdrola España any information requested in relation to the monitoring and progress of the master's degree as well as to send the assessments and results of the studies carried out within the deadlines granted. The scholarship recipient must provide Iberdrola España with their home address at their destination immediately upon arrival. They must also report any change of postal or email address while they are receiving the scholarship.
- If any publication arises from the master's degree studies funded by Iberdrola España, the scholarship recipient who is the author of the publication must notify Iberdrola España and state their status as an Iberdrola España scholarship recipient.
- The scholarship recipient undertakes to publicise their status as a scholarship recipient from Iberdrola España during the period of the scholarship.
- If the scholarship recipient fails to comply with the aforementioned commitments — or any other included in the scholarship conditions — Iberdrola España reserves the right to proceed as it deems appropriate, including requesting the return of any amounts received. Specifically if

the scholarship recipient does not complete their scholarship programme within the estimated period (1 September 2027 to 1 October 2027) they must repay Iberdrola España the total amount of monthly payments and other financial benefits received to date, if this occurs after the seventh month.

In any case Iberdrola España reserves the right to analyse the corresponding request for repayment and may modify or adjust the amount to be repaid by the scholarship recipient.

Furthermore Iberdrola España reserves the right to eliminate any participation in the scholarship call that defrauds, alters or invalidates the proper functioning and normal and regulatory course of this call. Any participant who, intentionally or unintentionally, harms or damages the image of Iberdrola, as well as that of the other participants, will also be eliminated.

9. Other conditions

- The scholarship recipient must sign up for Iberdrola España's selection and recruitment programme through the [Iberdrola Employment Channel](#).

The scholarship recipient undertakes to maintain strict confidentiality regarding all information received from Iberdrola España in connection with this grant. This confidentiality obligation shall remain in force for the duration of the scholarship.

10. Personal data protection

Iberdrola will process the personal data of the scholarship recipient or applicant in accordance with the provisions of the [aviso-privacidad-becas-master.pdf](#)

11. Modification of the scholarship conditions and revocation

Iberdrola reserves the right to modify or revoke this call for entries at any time for justified reasons, in which case Iberdrola will give notification via publication on the Iberdrola website.

12. Applicable law and jurisdiction

Spanish law shall govern the interpretation of this call for applications for scholarships. For all matters relating to the interpretation, compliance and enforcement of these conditions, Iberdrola and the participants, expressly waiving any other jurisdiction or privilege that may correspond to them, formally submit to the jurisdiction and competence of the Courts and Tribunals of Madrid.
